

A.C.E. JC1 H2 CHEMISTRY PROMO REVISION SERIES @ MY CHEM CAFE® (2021)

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At MY CHEM CAFE, we do not just offer crash course such as holiday intensive programme, as we believe that most students need time to assimilate knowledge they learn. Hence, we offer a 6-session promo revision programme (from August to Sept) to help students prepare well for the coming end-of-year (EOY) Promotional Examination. The first session would commence from **23rd August (Mon) 2021**. There will be no regular lesson during this period.

Key objectives of the programme:

1. To reinforce students' understanding on all major JC1 topics
2. To make links across topics and enable students to apply knowledge in answering questions
3. To identify and fill any gaps in students' learning

Overview of the programme

The revision consists of a 3-part series specially curated by Mr Jacky Wong. For Promo Revision Series 1, we would be covering on topics taught for the first half of JC1. They include: The Mole Concept and Stoichiometry (including redox calculations), Atomic Structure, Chemical Bonding, The Gaseous State and The Periodic Table (Physical Periodicity and chemistry of Period 3 oxides and chlorides). For Promo Revision Series 2, it would focus on Chemical Energetics, Reaction Kinetics, Chemical Equilibria, Organic Chemistry (Introduction, Isomerism and Alkanes). The final series consist of a 2-hour session on Planning based on selected topics. As we understand that the focus of examination is on the integration of topics learnt, Mr Jacky Wong has specially compiled sets of questions of varying levels of difficulty from past years' JCs Promos/Prelim to be given for practice and discussion.

Key features of the programme

Even though the focus of the revision is mainly on the common topics taught across most JCs, we do provide additional support for students who need help in topics such as acid-base and solubility equilibria via our complimentary online lesson. In addition, free extra sessions can be arranged for common topics of concern and students have unlimited access to consultation via what's app. Other than reinforcing key concepts learnt, examination answering techniques would also be taught in class. One of the key factors in getting a good grade in Chemistry lies not just in how well students know the subject but what the examiners require in an answer, knowing this can help students in sound time management for the papers.
